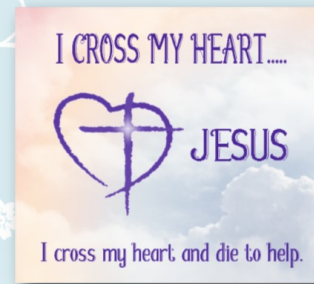

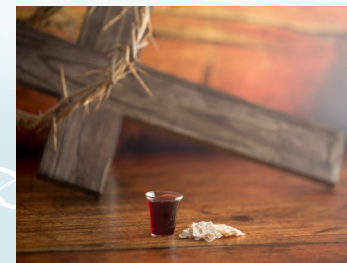
## HOLY WEEK 2019

### APRIL 18--MAUNDY THURSDAY



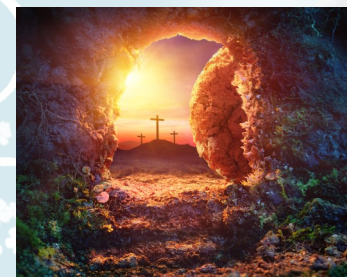
The Maundy Thursday service at 7:00 pm is a quiet, reflective service remembering the night Jesus established the memorial meal to help us remember His death and resurrection.

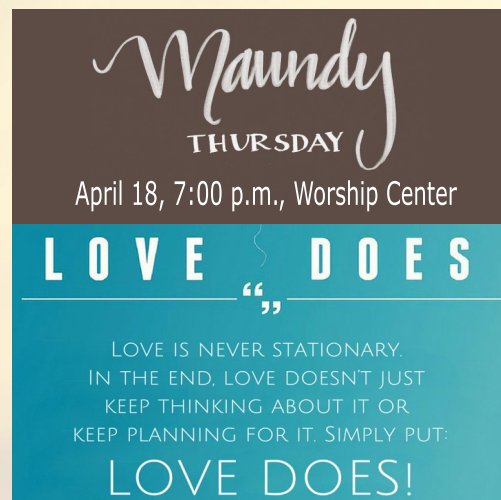

## FLC NEWS



The FLC has a new magnetic lock system on the main entry doors in place for safety purposes. The volunteer behind the front desk will have a remote control that will unlock the door.

If you come to visit the FLC, we want you to know that the door will remain in the locked position. When you hear the beep sound, the lock is being released and you can simply pull

the door open. The handle will remain in a locked position, so you will just need to pull on the handle instead of turning it first.

If no one is unlocking the door, you may use the intercom system next to the door to ring the front desk to let them know you are there.
