WORK IS UNDERWAY

The construction of the new storage expansion building and garage has begun on the west side of the church campus. This building will be twice as large as our current garage facility. Since we will triple our current space in the two permanent buildings, we can house our three vehicles and disaster relief trailer plus all of the things related to our *A South Main Bethlehem* experience and the Giant Youth Garage Sale. That will mean, of course, we will no longer need and can move the containers that are a bit unsightly.

This building is not being funded with budget receipts, nor are we taking out a loan. We are building this facility with some Capital Needs money in a savings account plus designated gifts. If you want to contribute toward the funding of this storage garage, simply write on your envelope "Storage Building." Weather permitting, it should be a relatively short term construction project.
